Breakaway Ranch Roping \$40

- Ropers use a breakaway honda, rope 5 head of cattle.
- On one side of the sorting pens.
- Great for novice ropers and those learning to dally.

3-Man Line Sorting \$40

- *Original sorting!!*
- 3 sorters work together to separate numbered cattle.
- 10 head at the end of the small arena.

—Saturday, July 25th at 5:00pm—

Ranch Sorting \$40

- 2 sorters work together sorting cattle through gate.
- 10 head in round sorting pens.

—Sunday, July 26th at 9:00am—

Team Penning \$60

- 3 riders separate 3 head of cattle from a herd of 30.
- Cattle are driven to small pen at opposite end of arena.

→ Pay cash or venmo @Merced-Horsemens

→ \$20 for each additional horse you ride.

→ Day membership \$20 per rider.

→ Youth is 50% of adult fees listed above. **Youth 17 and under MUST wear helmets while mounted.**

→ Due to increasing cattle costs, we unfortunately have to charge an extra \$5 per rider per event.
